Marta produces an early, heavy tuber set with excellent uniformity, making it highly marketable for both the fresh and baby potato markets. It features attractive light yellow skin and flesh, paired with rapid foliage development. Marta also demonstrates strong resistance to silver scurf, mechanical damage, bruising, PVY, and blackleg.
