AUSTRIAN CRESCENT

Austrian Crescent is a crescent-shaped tuber with smooth yellow skin and light yellow flesh. It is a strong option for the fresh market, performing exceptionally well in salads and offering excellent flavor when boiled, steamed, or roasted. This variety shows high resistance to PVY, resists bruising, and handles well during mechanical harvesting.
