



Dick Bedlington Farms

CAL WHITE

This oblong variety features rough, netted buff skin and white flesh and is a high yielder, producing fewer but larger tubers per plant. It is well suited for the baking and processing markets. With a thick stem and large plant structure, it performs well in hot climates, though heat sprouting may occur under high temperatures. This variety is susceptible to oversized tubers, common scab, storage soft rot, and PVY, but shows resistance to blackspot bruising and early dying. It stores well, has a short dormancy period, and offers medium to high specific gravity.
